



OUR TIPS FOR AN EASY POOL LINER INSTALLATION

To install or replace your above-ground pool cover in the best possible conditions, consider the following points:

Ideal conditions:

- **Outside temperature:** between 20°C and 30°C
- **Weather:** calm, sunny and dry
- **Soil:** clean, dry and level
- **Time of day:** morning or late afternoon

These conditions make the liner softer and more elastic, making it easier to install and adjust, while reducing the risk of tearing. A well-warmed liner conforms better to the shape of the pool and provides uniform tension, essential for preventing wrinkles and extending liner life.

Conditions to avoid :

- **Outside temperature:** below 15°C or above 35°C
- **Weather:** humid, windy or cool
- **Soil:** soggy, muddy or uneven
- **Time of day:** midday or early afternoon, especially in hot weather

Below 15°C, the liner becomes stiff, difficult to handle and more fragile. In very hot weather, it can become too soft, making precise adjustment difficult. Poorly prepared or damp ground can lead to sagging or stress points, causing long-term damage to the liner.
