### SECTION 2. HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

### SECTION 4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

**First-aid Measures**

**Inhalation**

Move to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, trained personnel should administer emergency oxygen if advised to do so by Poison Centre or doctor. Avoid mouth-to-mouth contact by using a barrier device.

**Skin Contact**

Wash with plenty of water.

**Eye Contact**

Immediately rinse the contaminated eye(s) with lukewarm, gently flowing water for at least 30 minutes, while holding the eyelid(s) open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice or attention.
